

Immediate™ Acrylic Resin

Intended Purpose

Fabrication, by a dental professional, of denture relines

Other Materials / Equipment Needed

1. Acrylic bur or ruby carver
2. Acrylic Primer (Acrylic bonding agent)
3. Brush
4. Spatula
5. Sharp knife or emery disc



Instructions for Use

For consistent results always shake liquid before use.

1. Clean and disinfect denture.
2. Trim down any high spots and relieve denture if necessary with acrylic burs or ruby carvers.
3. Coat denture area to be relined with Acrylic Primer.
4. Protect any surfaces not to be relined.
5. Mix approximately 2 parts Immediate™ powder with 1 part Immediate™ Liquid. Stir thoroughly for about one minute. Allow to gel for two minutes.
6. Spread mixture into the ridge area covering from the crest of the ridge to the periphery and across the post dam area. (When relining a lower denture, all tissue bearing surfaces of the denture should be covered.)
7. Place denture into patient's mouth and have patient close mouth slowly to a biting position. Bring teeth to occlusion and have patient suck in cheeks to muscle trim.

8. After three minutes remove denture from patient's mouth to check coverage and muscle trim. Add or trim material as needed.

9. Replace denture into patient's mouth and have patient hold a light biting position for about five minutes.

10. Remove denture and trim as needed using a sharp knife or an emery disc.

Handling Precautions

Contains methyl methacrylate

Danger. Highly flammable liquid and vapor. Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surface. – No smoking.

Causes skin irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction.

May cause respiratory irritation.

Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection.

Keep material in original container tightly closed in upright position. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool.

Disposal

Dispose of contents and container in accordance with all local, regional and national regulations.

Warranty

Manufacturer warrants this product to be free from manufacturing defects for one year from date of purchase only from an authorized reseller. Warranty is void if product is not used for intended purpose, not used as instructed or not stored in original container.
